The holiday season is fast approaching and that means it is time for the annual KPMA Holiday Wreath Sale! This is one of our largest fundraisers and we need the help of *all our music students* to make it successful. This is where **YOU** can help give back to the program that has given you so much!

The cost is \$17.00 per wreath – bows are an additional \$3 (\$20 for both wreath and bow). Each student is asked to sell 6 or more wreaths to make this fundraiser as successful as possible. Prizes will be awarded to top sellers!

- Wreaths are fresh, nursery quality 12" (outside spread is 24") double-sided evergreen.
- Almost everyone buys a wreath so this is an easy sell!
- Money raised goes towards the needs of the **entire music program**, including the high school and middle school bands and chorus. Our fundraising efforts have allowed us to purchase basics like music stands, instruments, awards for MICCA gold winners, as well as provide free summer music lessons for elementary school kids, percussion lessons at elementary schools and middle school, chambers, leadership classes, scholarships and so much more.

- 1. Sell, Sell, Sell ask parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, neighbors and friends (social media works great).

- 4. Come to the high school on Saturday, Nov. 18th with cash or check to KPMA & pick up your order.
- 5. Distribute wreaths to your customers, just in time for holiday decorating!
